

# Book Explorers

Lewis & Clark's Reading Program



Book Explorers is a school-wide reading program for Lewis and Clark students. The goal of the program is to motivate students to read independently and daily outside of school hours.

Students will set monthly and yearly goals. Goals will be based on minutes read per month. For example, sixth grade students may have the goal of reading 200 minutes per month, while first grade students may have the goal of 100 minutes per month. Students that achieve their monthly goals will be rewarded with the following recognition.

## Individual Recognition

### Monthly:

- Picture on display
- Name in newsletter
- Name announced on intercom
- Small prize (i.e. pencil, pen)
- Name in monthly drawing for book

### Yearly:

- Two Books
- Certificate

Classrooms will also set monthly goals. For example, a sixth grade class may set their monthly goal at 3,600 minutes (200 minutes X 18 students). When classes reach their goals, they will earn an Explorer to put outside their classroom doors, as well as the following recognition.

## Class Recognition

### Monthly:

- Picture on display
- Name in newsletter
- Name announced on intercom
- **Explorer** outside door

### Yearly:

- Seven **Explorers** equals party
